<b>Duration</b>	Two Days
<b>Group Size</b>	Maximum 8 delegates
<b>Who Should Attend</b>	All persons who will be required by their employer to undertake the MLC technique as an advance warning vehicle driver on motorways and/or dual carriageways
<b>Course Aims</b>	To provide delegates with the necessary knowledge to assist them in becoming a competent member of an MLC team.
<b>Course Objectives</b>	On completion of the session delegates will: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Understand the principles of Sector schemes, general health and safety at work, risk assessments and method statements associated with the mobile traffic management industry.</li><li>• Reference documentation relevant to the mobile lane closure technique.</li><li>• Training and assessment requirements for MLC personnel</li><li>• Vehicle and equipment specification</li><li>• Communications roles and responsibilities</li><li>• MLC principles and practical techniques</li><li>• The types of work that require full mobile lane closure techniques and the limitations.</li></ul>
<b>Certification</b>	On completion all candidates will undertake a multiple choice question paper which carries a 75% pass mark. Lantra Awards (the National HSTM award body) will make certification for successful candidates. Full completion of the award can be achieved over a further period of a maximum 12 months, by undertaking on site assessments with a suitably qualified assessor in accordance with the award body's scheme rules.
