TRAFFIC SAFETY AND CONTROL OFFICERS (TSCO)

Please note the following:

This card will indicate that the candidate has completed and passed the 12A/12B Foreman course as a requirement to operate as a Traffic Safety and Control Officer **only**. The cardholder is **not** a qualified Operative or Foreman unless they also carry the Traffic Management Registration Scheme card to the appropriate level.

All applicants must have successfully passed the Sector Scheme 12A/12B Foreman Course with a pass mark of 75% or above. Candidates must either hold an approved Lantra Awards 12A/12B Foreman Course certificate or a Lantra Awards Traffic Management identity card which includes the 12A/12B Foreman categories.

For those wishing to qualify as TSCO or re accredited from the 1 July 2008, the following criteria must be achieved before ID registration card will be issued:

- Certificate of achievement from the foreman's training course for National Highway Sector Scheme 12A.
- Certificate of achievement for a 4 day first aid course
- A Health & Safety Qualification. This may be:
 - IOSH – Working Safely – This is a one day course for staff from any sector with no supervisory or managerial responsibility.
 - IOSH – Managing Safely
 - IOSH - Directing Safely
 - CITB - Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS)
 - CITB – Site Supervisors Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS)
 - NeBOSH – General Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – Certificate in Construction Health and Safety
 - NeBOSH – International general certificate in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – National Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health
 - NeBOSH – International Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health
- Passed the Lantra Awards training and assessment for Traffic Safety and Control Officer Course

As detailed in the Specification for Highway Works the above requirement will become mandatory from the 1 April 2009.
